Offender Charged with Multiple Felonies Including Attempted Murder

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Assault/Peace Officer/Fire/ER Worker
One (1) felony count – Domestic Battery - Aggravated
Five (5) felony counts – Aggravated Discharge Firearm - Vehicle/Sch
Three (3) felony counts – Reckless Discharge Firearm - Endanger
One (1) felony count – Felon Possess Weapon
One (1) Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – January 26, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on January 23, 2026, at 7:51 p.m., in the 8000 block of S. Ingleside Ave. He was identified as the offender who, less than 10 minutes earlier, shot and seriously injured a 22-year-old female victim in the 7900 block of S. Ingleside Ave. (6th District). Additionally, when officers arrived, the armed offender attempted to flee and fired a weapon in the direction of officers. Two officers then discharged their service weapons, striking the offender. The offender was placed into custody and charges were secured by the Investigative Response Team in partnership with the Cook County State's Attorney's Office. No additional information is available at this time.
