### Offender Charged with Multiple Felony Counts, Including Murder, Aggravated Battery, Burglary & Armed Robbery



**Offender:** Muhammad Thomas, 35  
500 block of N. Troy St., Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** Two (2) felony counts – Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Peace Officer  
Two (2) felony counts – Robbery - Armed - Discharge Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed - Other Dangerous Weapon  
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Burglary  
Three (3) Issuances of Warrant

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – February 27, 2026

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on February 24, 2026, in the 200 block of S. Tucker St. in St. Louis, Missouri. He was identified as the offender who, on November 8, 2025, burglarized a business in the 3800 block of W. 26<sup>th</sup> St. (10<sup>th</sup> District). While fleeing from the location, the offender fatally shot a 25-year-old male victim and a 63-year-old male victim. The offender is also charged with shooting and seriously injuring a 26-year-old male victim on July 28, 2023, in the 1700 block of W. Maypole Ave. (12<sup>th</sup> District), as well as a July 16, 2024 armed robbery in the 2300 block of W. Cermak Rd. (10<sup>th</sup> District). The offender was located in Missouri, extradited to Chicago and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
