Offender Charged with Murder of a Chicago Police Department Officer and Attempted Murder of a Second Chicago Police Department Officer



Offender: Alphanso Talley, 26

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 27, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on April 25, 2026, at 12:15 p.m., in the 2600 block of W. Carmen Ave. He was identified as the offender who, less than two hours earlier, fatally shot a Chicago Police Department Officer in the 2700 block of W. Foster Ave (20th District). The offender also shot and critically injured a second Chicago Police Department Officer during this incident. The offender fled the scene and was later taken into custody, where a weapon was recovered. The offender is also charged in connection with an armed robbery that occurred earlier in the day in the 3200 block of W. Lawrence Ave. (17th District). No additional information is available at this time.
