### Offender Charged with August 2024 Murder of 29-Year-Old Male



**Offender:** Christopher Ford, 24  
3500 block of S. Rhodes Ave.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Murder - Strong Probability Death/Injure  
Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
Three (3) felony counts – Aggravated Discharge Firearm - Occupied Vehicle  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – August 28, 2025

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on August 25, 2025, in the 7600 block of S. Coles. He was identified as one of the offenders who, on August 18, 2024, fatally shot a 29-year-old male and shot and critically injured a 29-year-old female who were inside a vehicle in the 1800 block of S. Loomis (12<sup>th</sup> District). A 27-year-old female was also in the vehicle at the time but was not injured. The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
