Offender Charged with Attempt Murder and Armed Robbery of 23-Year-Old Male

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed - Other Dangerous Weapon
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – June 27, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department's Area Two Homicide Team and Investigation Support Team on June 26, 2025, in the 2700 block of S. California Ave. He was identified as the offender who, on March 23, 2024, battered and seriously injured a 23-year-old male in the 11500 block of S. Princeton Ave. (5th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
