### Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 46-Year-Old Female



**Offender:** Andre Doyle, 37  
7100 block of S. Champlain Ave.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt – Murder – First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Domestic Battery - Aggravated  
One (1) felony count – Felon Possess Weapon

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – June 27, 2026

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on June 24, 2026, at 11:21 p.m. in the 7100 block of S. Champlain Ave. He was identified as the offender who, approximately one hour earlier, shot and injured a 46-year-old female victim in the 4600 block of S. Ellis Ave. (2<sup>nd</sup> District). The offender was quickly placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
