Preliminary Statement on Police-Involved Shooting in the 3700 block of W. 67th PI.

CHICAGO – On Monday, April 28, 2025, at approximately 4:18 a.m., an off-duty Chicago Police officer was confronted by multiple armed offenders in the 3700 block of W. 67th PI. (8th District), and an exchange of gunfire ensued. The armed offenders then entered a dark-colored sedan and fled the scene westbound. The officer sustained a minor injury and was transported to an area hospital for observation. No other injuries have been reported at this time. The Investigative Response Team is on the scene investigating.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department.

The officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a minimum period of 30 days. This matter remains under investigation and all further inquiries can be directed to the Civilian Office of Police Accountability at (312) 746-3609.
