**Juvenile Offender Charged with Multiple Counts of Armed Robbery** 



Offender: Male juvenile, 17

**Charges:** Three (3) felony counts – Robbery - Armed with Firearm

Two (2) felony counts – Robbery

One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm

One (1) misdemeanor count – Obstructing Identification

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on March 27, 2025, in the 1100 block of S.

Central Park Ave. He was identified as an offender who, on March 21, 2025, at 9:10 p.m., participated in taking property at gunpoint from two victims, a 16-year-old female and a 17-year-old male, while on a train in the 400 block of S. Racine Ave. (12<sup>th</sup> District). He is also charged in connection to an armed robbery and aggravated vehicle hijacking of a 57-year-old male that occurred less than an hour later in the 3600 block of W. Grenshaw St. (11<sup>th</sup> District). In addition, the offender was identified as having participated in forcefully taking property from two victims, a 25-year-old male and a 38-year-old male, on march 13, 2025, while on a train in the 400 block of S. Western Ave. (12<sup>th</sup> District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
