Juvenile Offender Charged with Multiple Counts of Armed Robbery



Offender: Male juvenile, 17

Charges: Three (3) felony counts – Robbery - Armed with Firearm
Two (2) felony counts – Robbery
One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm
One (1) misdemeanor count – Obstructing Identification

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on March 27, 2025, in the 1100 block of S. Central Park Ave. He was identified as an offender who, on March 21, 2025, at 9:10 p.m., participated in taking property at gunpoint from two victims, a 16-year-old female and a 17-year-old male, while on a train in the 400 block of S. Racine Ave. (12th District). He is also charged in connection to an armed robbery and aggravated vehicle hijacking of a 57-year-old male that occurred less than an hour later in the 3600 block of W. Grenshaw St. (11th District). In addition, the offender was identified as having participated in forcefully taking property from two victims, a 25-year-old male and a 38-year-old male, on March 13, 2025, while on a train in the 400 block of S. Western Ave. (12th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
