## Offender Charged with Multiple Felonies, Including Attempted Murder of Chicago Police Officers

- Offender: Sidi Mohamed Abdallahi, 22 100 block of E. 115<sup>th</sup> St., Chicago, Illinois
- Charges: Six (6) felony counts Attempt Murder First Degree Seven (7) felony counts – Aggravated Discharge Firearm - PO/Firefighter One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
- **Court:** Detention Hearing 2600 S. California October 29, 2024
- **Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on October 26, 2024, at 10 a.m., in the 6800 block of N. Washtenaw. He was identified as the offender who, less than 30 minutes earlier, shot a 39-year-old male in the 2600 block of W. Farwell (24<sup>th</sup> District). The offender then fired at responding officers and paramedics multiple times from various locations. Officers returned fire, striking the offender. No members of the Chicago Police Department or the Chicago Fire Department members were injured. A weapon was recovered on the scene. The offender was placed into custody, transported to an area hospital and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
