Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of Chicago Police Officers



Offender: Barry Hayes, 32
4100 block of W. Washington Blvd.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
Two (2) felony counts – Criminal Damage/Govt Property/>\$500-\$10K
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Peace Officer
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Assault Peace Off/Fire/ER Wrk
One (1) felony count – Leave Scene of Accident - Injury/Death

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – August 29, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on August 27, 2025, at 5:07 a.m., in the 5800 block of S. Princeton Ave. He was identified as the offender who, moments earlier, was driving an SUV in the 5800 block of S. Princeton (7th District) when he accelerated rapidly, striking an officer. The offender continued driving toward responding officers, striking a marked squad car. The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
