Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of a Chicago Police Officer



Offender: Isaiah Martinez, 30
3500 block of W. Cermak Rd
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Discharge Firearm/Veh/Pc Off/Fireman
One (1) felony count – Armed Violence/Discharge Weapon
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Peace Officer
One (1) felony count – Possess Firearm Repeat Felon Offender
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Possession Stolen Motor Vehicle
One (1) felony count – Criminal Damage/Govt Prop/<\$500
Two (2) misdemeanor counts – Fleeing/Attempt Elude Officer
Three (3) citations - Stop at Stop Sign

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – October 30, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on October 27, 2025, at 4:10 p.m., in the 6100 block of W. Eastwood Ave. He was identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, struck a Chicago Police vehicle while officers were attempting a traffic stop in the 4900 block of N. Milwaukee Ave. (16th District). The offender fired at least one shot, striking the Chicago Police vehicle before causing a traffic crash with another CPD vehicle. The offender then fled on foot before being placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
