Offender Charged with Attempted Murder and Aggravated Battery of 26-Year-Old Male



Offender: Jose Montilla-Carreno, 23
4500 block of S. Honore St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – January 31, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by the Chicago Police Department Area One Homicide Investigation Support Team on January 29, 2026, at 9:30 p.m., in the 1800 block of W. 43rd St. He was identified as the offender who, approximately 12 hours earlier, shot and seriously injured a 26-year-old male victim in the 6300 block of S. Paulina St. (7th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
