Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of Chicago Police Officer



Offender: Menard Allison, 34
6200 block of S. Laflin St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - Strong Probability Death/Injure
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Discharge Firearm - Police Officer/Fireman
One (1) felony count – UUW - Weapon - Felon Possess Weapon/2nd+
One (1) felony count – Violate Sex Offender Registration
One (1) felony count – PCS - Possession - Possess Amt Con Sub Except (A) (D)
Five (5) misdemeanor counts – Resisting/Obstruct/PC Off/Corr Emp/Frfr
One (1) Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – March 31, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on March 28, 2026, at 7:59 p.m., in the 6400 block of S. Green St. He was identified as the offender who, less than 15 minutes earlier, discharged a firearm in the direction of a Chicago Police officer in the 6400 block of S. Green St. (7th District). No one was struck by gunfire, and the officer did not return fire. The offender attempted to flee on foot unsuccessfully. He was quickly taken into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
