Offender Charged with Murder of Off-Duty Cook County Sheriff's Deputy

- **Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on July 30, 2024, at 4:05 a.m., in the 200 block of E. Huron. He was identified as the offender who, several hours earlier, shot and killed off-duty Cook County Sheriff's Deputy Rafael Wordlaw, 31, during an attempted robbery in the 500 block of E. 67th St. (3rd District). A 30-year-old male victim on scene was also shot at and sustained minor injuries. The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
