Offender Charged with Attempt Murder of 48-Year-Old Male



Offender: Ivan Weldon, 42
1400 block of S. Canal St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count - Aggravated Battery/Peace Officer
Three (3) felony counts - Aggravated Battery/Public Place
Two (2) felony counts - Aggravated Battery/Transit Employee
One (1) misdemeanor count - Theft - Labor/Services/Property
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – June 3, 2024

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Bureau of Counter Terrorism Mass Transit Team on May 31, 2024, at approximately 11:49 p.m. in the 100 block of N. Wells St. He was identified as the offender who, four hours earlier, stabbed and injured a 48-year-old male victim while on a CTA Train in the 300 block of E. Garfield Blvd. (2nd District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
