### Juvenile Offender Charged with Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking, Multiple Weapons Violations



**Offender:** Male juvenile, 16

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated – Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Assault/Discharge Firearm  
One (1) felony count – UUW - Weapon - Possess/Carry /Conceal Weapon  
One (1) misdemeanor count – Firearm without Valid FOID/Elig  
One (1) misdemeanor count – Possess Ammunition without Valid FOID  
One (1) citation – Possess of a Laser Sight Accessory, Firearm Silencer, Muffler  
One (1) citation – High Cap Mag and Metal Piercing Bullets - Sale/Poss Prohibited

**Court:** Juvenile Court – 1100 S. Hamilton – March 2, 2022

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on March 1, 2022 at 9:11 a.m. in the 7000 block of W. Grand. He was identified as one of the offenders who, less than three hours earlier, took a vehicle at gunpoint from a 40-year-old male in the 3100 block of N. St. Louis (14<sup>th</sup> District). The offender is also charged in connection to firing a shot at the victim, who was not injured, during the struggle for the vehicle. The offender was placed into custody, at which time a weapon was recovered, and he was subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
