### Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 1-Year-Old Boy, 30-Year-Old Female



**Offender:** Michael Williams, 30  
5900 block of W. Iowa  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Aggr Discharge Firearm – Occupied Bldg  
One (1) felony count – Uuw – Weapon – Felon, Possess/Use Firearm

**Court:** Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – June 3, 2021

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on June 2, 2021 at 1:21 a.m. in the 7200 block of N. Sheridan. He was identified as the offender who, several hours earlier, at approximately 11:43 p.m., shot and injured a 1-year-old male and a 30-year-old female in the 5200 block of W. Congress 15<sup>th</sup> District (Austin). The offender fled the scene and was later observed by officers on patrol, who conducted a traffic stop. The offender was then placed into custody without incident and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
