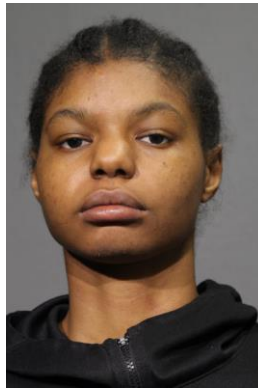

### Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 33-Year-Old-Male



**Offender:** Indya Smith, 23  
1000 block of W. Leland Ave.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt- Murder- First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery / Discharge Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated UUW / Person / No FOID  
One (1) Citation - Weapon on CTA

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – October 4, 2024

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by Loyola University Officers, in conjunction with Chicago Police Department, on October 2, 2024, at approximately 9:06 a.m., in the 5800 block of N. Broadway (20<sup>th</sup> District). She was identified as the offender who, on October 2, 2024, at approximately 8:40 a.m., was involved in a verbal altercation with a 33-year-old male, produced a firearm and shot him in the shoulder in the 5000 block of N. Broadway (20<sup>th</sup> District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
