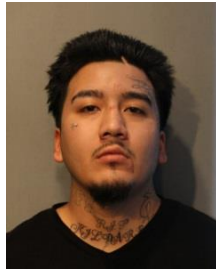

Offenders Charged with Murder of 49-Year-Old Male

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder – First Degree
Twelve (12) felony counts – Robbery – Armed – Other Dangerous Weapon
Nine (9) felony counts - Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon
Four (4) felony counts – Criminal Damage to Property \$500-\$10K
One (1) felony count – Attempt – Robbery – Armed – Other Dangerous Weapon
One (1) felony count - Burglary
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Unlawful Restraint
Issuance of Warrant

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder – First Degree
Ten (10) felony counts – Robbery – Armed – Other Dangerous Weapon
Nine (9) felony counts - Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon
Four (4) felony counts - Criminal Damage to Property
One (1) felony count - Burglary

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – March 4, 2022

Narrative: Mendiola and Barrios were identified as the offenders who, on December 11, 2021, beat a 49-year-old male in the 3500 block of W. 55th Street (8th District), resulting in his death. They are also responsible for a series of crimes that same day. Both offenders were taken into custody without incident and charged accordingly.
