About This Crime

On Monday May 6, 2024, at approximately 07:30 A.M., a 15-year-old female juvenile was waiting for the bus on the 4900 Block of North Central Avenue when she observed an unknown male black offender in a vehicle. The offender rolled down his window and stated, "get in, what's your number"? The juvenile got on the bus southbound on Central with the unknown offender following the bus. The juvenile got off the bus at Montrose where she waited for the bus again. The unknown offender parked his vehicle nearby, exited his vehicle and called out to the juvenile. The juvenile, in fear, began walking northbound on Central from Montrose. The unknown offender continued to follow her and repeated for her to "get in" before finally driving away.

About The Offender

- The offender was described as a male black, approximately 30-40 years of age, with a shaved head and a moustache. The unknown male wore black pants, white tee shirt and a black jacket. No further description. The vehicle is described as an older tan or brown 4 door SUV with no license plates.

What You Can Do

- Be aware of this situation and alert your neighbors.
- Call 911 to report any suspicious persons, vehicles or activity in your neighborhood.
- Do not let children walk alone. Identify safe havens along your child's route to school, such as businesses or trusted neighbors.
