About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to businesses operating within the 001st District (Central) on beat 0122, 012th District (Near West) on beats 1213, 1215, and 1221, 018th District (Near North) on beat 1831, 019th District (Town Hall) on beats 1922, 1932, 1935 of multiple burglaries where force was used to the smash front glass windows or doors are pried open to gain entry. Safes, register drawers, electronics and large amount of clothing and money are taken.

- Call 911 immediately if you are a victim or witness to a crime and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information.
- If approached by a witness to an incident, request they remain on the scene when possible or obtain contact information.
