Offender Charged with Multiple Felony Counts of Aggravated Battery, Attempted Robbery



Offender: William Livingston, 28
400 block of E. 113th St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Four (4) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Public Place
Two (2) felony counts – Attempt – Robbery
One (1) misdemeanor count – Battery - Make Physical Contact

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – February 10, 2022

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on February 8, 2022, at 12:26 p.m. in the 100 block of S. State. He was identified as the offender who struck and attempted to take personal property from multiple female victims within minutes of each other in the 1st District. The incidents occurred:

- 12 p.m. in the 700 block of S. State (30-year-old victim)
- 12:09 p.m. in the 0-100 block of E. Van Buren (25-year-old victim)
- 12:11 p.m. in the 0-100 block of E. Jackson (25-year-old victim)
- 12:22 p.m. in the 0-100 block of E. Monroe (27 & 49-year-old victims)

The offender was placed into custody by responding officers and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
