Man Charged with Attempted First Degree Murder in CTA Bus Incident



Offender: Fred White, 37
5500 block of S. Racine Ave
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggr Discharge Firearm-Occupied Vehicle
One (1) felony count – UUW – Weapon – Felon, Possess / Use Firearm
One (1) felony count – Poss Firearm W / Defaced Serial Number
Two (2) – Issuance of Warrant

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – June 10, 2021

Narrative: Fred White was arrested on June 8, 2021 at 10:36 p.m. in the 11800 block of S. Princeton Ave. He was identified as the individual who fired shots at a CTA bus driver after she asked him to wear his mask in the 300 block of W. 119 St. (5th District) on June 8, 2021, at approximately 10:34 p.m. White was placed into custody without incident and charged accordingly.
