Previously, he was a deputy chief for the Bureau of Organized Crime and the commander of the 6th District. As a sergeant, the commander served in many areas of the Department including the former Area Central, the 2nd (Wentworth) District, Area 2 Detective Division and the Asset Forfeiture Unit. Commander Bradley holds master's degrees in Business Administration from Loyola University and Police Psychology from Adler School of Professional Psychology. He earned a bachelor's degree in Law Enforcement Management from Calumet College of St. Joseph. He also attended the Police Executive Research Forum's Senior Management Institute for Police program

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
