Juvenile Offender Charged with 10 Felonies, Including Attempted Murder, Aggravated Battery, Armed Robbery and Home Invasion



Offender: Male juvenile, 14

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Attempt – Murder – First Degree
Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
Two (2) felony counts – Robbery – Armed with Firearm
Four (4) felony counts – Home Invasion/Dangerous Weapon

Court: Juvenile Court – 1100 S. Hamilton – December 14, 2022

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on December 13, 2022, in the 1100 block of S. Hamilton. He was identified as the offender who, on November 15, 2022, entered a residence in the 11600 block of S. Yale (5th District), committed armed robbery and then opened fire. A 15-year-old male and an 18-year-old male were both shot and critically injured. The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
