Motor Vehicle Thefts 002nd District (Wentworth)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens in the 002nd District (Wentworth) of recent motor vehicle theft incidents. In each of the incidents, the victim legally parked her vehicle and when she returned the vehicle was missing. The involved vehicles are various makes and models. Incident times and locations are listed below:

Incident times and locations:

- 4400 block of south Drexel Blvd. on July 15, 2024 at 6:00 A.M.
- 4600 block of south Evans Ave. between July 17, 2024 at 10:30 P.M. and July 18, 2024 at 5:00 A.M.
- 400 block of east 46th St. between July 19, 2024 at 10:45 P.M. and July 20, 2024 at 12:00 A.M.

What you can do:

- Do not leave your keys in your vehicle or your vehicle running unattended.
- Install and activate anti-theft devices.
- Park in well-lit, heavily traveled areas.
- Report suspicious activity immediately.
- Keep your vehicle doors and windows secured.
- Be aware of these crimes and alert your neighbors.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information.
- Kia and Hyundai owners can obtain anti-theft steering wheel locks from their local CAPS office.
- At all 22 police districts, residents can have a special, traceable marking etched into their vehicle's catalytic converter.
- Residents can be reimbursed for the cost of their GPS tracking device by registering with the City.
