### ***ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK – DEERING (9<sup>th</sup>) DISTRICT***

The Chicago Police Department will conduct a Roadside Safety Check in the Deering (9<sup>th</sup>) District at 5301 S. Ashland Ave. The Roadside Safety Check will commence at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, December 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014 and end at 3:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

During roadside safety checks, police officers slow down traffic, stop cars at regular intervals and watch for drivers who show signs of alcohol impairment and other violations as noted below.

“This program is conducted year round to ensure drivers are operating their vehicles safely,” said Superintendent, Garry F. McCarthy. “This is part of an ongoing strategy to keep the city streets safe for Chicago’s residents and commuters.”

The Roadside Safety Check conducted in the Grand Crossing (3<sup>rd</sup>) District on December 19-20, 2014 resulted in the following:
