Detectives Asking for Help in Identifying More Burglary Victims from the Area of the 19th District and 20th District

Public Invited to Claim Property at the Bureau of Detectives-Area North Auditorium

CHICAGO – Chicago Police have recovered numerous unclaimed items including, but not limited to cameras, laptops and jewelry such as wedding bands and several other rings with precious stones. During an investigation, 2 offenders were arrested and charged relating to multiple burglaries in the area of the 19th (Town Hall) District and the 20th (Lincoln) District.

Daunta Head was charged with four felony counts of Burglary-Residential, one felony count of Burglary and three felony counts of Theft. Patrice Banks was charged with three felony counts of Theft and one misdemeanor count of Theft. Head appeared in Central Bond Court on November 14, 2014. Banks appeared in Central Bond Court on November 21, 2014.

Area North Detectives are inviting the public to identify and claim their stolen property. The items are believed to be specifically from victims in the area of the 19th (Town Hall) District and 20th (Lincoln) District, who were burglarized earlier this year between March and November.

Anyone who has been the victim of a burglary in the area is encouraged to attend and identify stolen items at the Bureau of Detectives-Area North Auditorium, 2452 W. Belmont Ave., on Friday, December 5, 2014 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Persons wishing to claim stolen items must be able to provide proof of purchase or ownership.
