Correction Commercial Burglaries 014th District (Shakespeare)

About the Crime:

There have been recent Commercial Burglaries in the 014th District. In these cases, unknown offenders forcibly enter businesses by throwing a brick through the front window, or by prying open the rear door, and then enter business and take USC, and other merchandise.

- 1800 Block of W. Webster on 10 January 10 2015 at 5:30 a.m.
- 2200 Block of N. Elston on 10 January 2015 at 8:30 a.m.

About the Offender:

One unknown male offender was seen in one case. There are unknown offender(s) and no further description in the other cases.
