Wanted for Residential Burglary 11th District (Harrison)

About the crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 11th District (Harrison) of two burglaries that occurred on January 26, 2015. In both of these incidents, unknown offender(s) made entry into apartments and took property. In one incident, the offender made entry through a back door and took a video game system and jewelry. In the other incident, the offenders made entry through a window and took jewelry.

Incident times and locations:

Both of these two burglaries occurred on Beat 1124 in the afternoon hours.

- 3100 Block of West Monroe Street on January 26, 2015 at 12:00 p.m.
- 3000 Block of West Jackson Boulevard on January 26, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this crime pattern and alert your friends and family about these crimes.
- Make sure all doors and windows are locked.
- Keep the perimeter of your property well lit.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious subjects loitering in the area.
- If video surveillance is available, save and make a copy for the investigating detectives.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s), including any vehicle description and license plate information, as well as direction of flight, if known.
