Commercial Robberies 016th District (Jefferson Park) & 025th District (Grand Central)

About the Crime:

There have been three recent Commercial Robberies in the 16th and 25th District. In these cases, a male white Hispanic offender enters the business, displays a Chrome/Silver handgun and demands money from the register.

Incident times and locations:

- 6000 Block of W. Irving Park on January 21, 2015, at 3:23 p.m.
- 6700 Block of W. Belmont on February 10, 2015, at 3:53 p.m.
- 6000 Block of W. Higgins on February 11, 2015, at 2:05 a.m..

About the Offender:

Offender is described as a male white Hispanic offender approximately 5'10"-6'00", 160-180 lbs., wearing a black mask covering his face and displays a Chrome/Silver handgun with a brown handle.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this crime and alert other businesses.
- Business owners should ensure that their businesses are equipped with a working video surveillance system.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information as well as direction of flight, if known.
