West Side Man Charged with Murder and Armed Robbery



Name: Deshawn Johnson, 26
5200 block of W. Quincy St.

Charges: One Felony Count of Murder – First Degree
Four Felony Counts of Attempt - Murder
Two Felony Counts of Armed Robbery/Discharge Firearm
One Felony Count of Armed Robbery/With Firearm

Bond: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – February 20, 2015

Narrative: Johnson was arrested and charged after he entered a restaurant and fatally shot a 41-year-old male during an armed robbery on October 31, 2014, at approx. 7:10 pm on the 5200 block of W. Madison. Through the course of the investigation, Johnson was also identified as the offender who entered a liquor store on July 26, 2014 on the 3100 block of W. Montrose. Johnson then robbed the store at gunpoint and fired a shot at a male victim. Johnson was subsequently taken into custody and charged accordingly. There is no further information.
