South Side Man Charged in West Side Burglary

0-100 block of W. 112th Pl.

Charges: One Felony Count of Burglary
One Felony Count of Burglary-Possession of Burglary Tools
Two Misdemeanor Counts of Aggravated Assault of a Police Officer

Bond: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – January 31, 2015

Narrative: The above offender was arrested and charged after he was observed by Austin (015th) District officers on the roof of a business in the 5300 block of W. Harrison St. on January 30, 2015, at approximately 4:05 am. As the officers approached, the offender threatened to shoot the officers. The offender was subsequently taken into custody and charged accordingly. There were no reported injuries to officers and there was no weapon recovered. Further investigation revealed the offender had burglarized the store of numerous items, which were recovered. There is no further information.
