## **Wanted for Residential Burglaries 025<sup>th</sup> District (Grand Central)**

### **About the Crime:**

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 25<sup>th</sup> District (Grand Central) of several recent residential burglaries that have occurred. In these incidents, unknown offender(s) have entered apartments and residences, through windows or doors, and have taken electronics, jewelry, cash, and other miscellaneous items.

### **Incident times and locations:**

There have been seven incidents that have occurred since February 6, 2015. These incidents have taken place on Beats 2514 & 2515, within the boundaries of Austin to Laramie and Belmont to Armitage, mostly during the day and early evening hours.
