## **Brighton Park Man Charged with Attempted Murder**



Name: Jose Mena. 19

3100 block of West 39th Place

Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One count of Attempt Murder – First Degree

One misdemeanor count of Obstructing Identification

**Bond:** Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015

Narrative: Jose Mena was arrested in connection to a shooting that occurred on the

3100 block of West 38<sup>th</sup> Place at approx. 7:15 pm on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015. Mena was charged after being identified as the offender who, during an argument, shot a 20 year old male in the chest and wrist with a handgun. The victim was transported to Mt. Sinai Hospital where he was treated for his wounds. Mena was arrested a short distance away by officers responding to the shooting. During the investigation, Mena gave officers a false name and birth date and was charged accordingly. He is expected to appear in Central Bond Court

later this afternoon.
