2 felony counts of Aggravated Assault/Peace Officer/Weapon
2 felony counts of Aggravated Discharge Firearm –Veh/School
2 felony counts of Unlawful Possession of Firearm by Street Gang Member on Person

Watts:

1 felony count of Aggravated Battery to Peace Officer
1 felony count of Resisting/Obstruct/Peace Officer/Corr Emp/Firefighter Injury
1 felony count of UYW – Weapon – Felon/Parole-Possess/Use Firearm Prior
1 felony count of UYW – Weapon – Felon Possess/Use Firearm/Parole

Narrative: On May 19, 2015 at approximately 9:15 p.m. in the 6100 block of S. Laflin, officers heard shots fired in the area and observed two males running down the street with objects in their hands. Officers attempted to stop these males for investigation and a foot chase ensued. During the foot chase, there was an exchange of gunfire but no injuries were reported. An Officer sustained minor injuries during the foot pursuit and was treated and released from an area hospital. Crenshaw and Watts were arrested and charged accordingly.
