## Kenwood Man Charged in Park Manor Murder



Name: Romell V. Outlaw. 25

**Charges:** One felony count of Murder – First Degree

Two felony counts of Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm

**Bond:** Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – May 23, 2015

Narrative: Romell Outlaw was arrested in connection to a murder that occurred on the

on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015. Outlaw was charged after being identified as the offender who fatally shot a 37 year old man as he stood on the 100 block of East 69<sup>th</sup> Street at approx. 8:25 pm in the evening. The victim sustained a gunshot wound to the back and was transported to Stroger Hospital, where he was ultimately pronounced. Outlaw was arrested on the 4500 block of South Drexel at apprx. 11:10 a.m. on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2015 and is expected to appear in Central Bond Court later today. No further details are available at this time.
