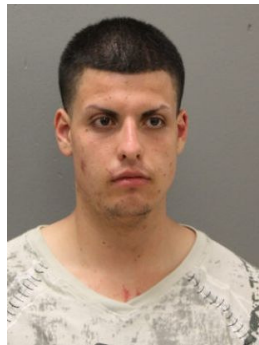

### Chicago Lawn Man Charged in Double Murder



**Name:** Jose Guzman, 20  
3800 block of W. 55<sup>th</sup> Pl.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** Two counts of Murder – First Degree  
Two counts of Home Invasion/Great Bodily Harm  
Two counts of Arson-Aggravated Arson/Bodily Harm  
One count of Robbery-Armed-Other Dangerous Weapon

**Bond:** Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – May 31, 2015

**Narrative:** Jose Guzman was arrested in connection to a double murder that occurred on May 28, 2015, at approximately 2:40 pm on the 3600 block of W. 55<sup>th</sup> Pl. Guzman was taken into custody after detectives determined he was responsible for the deaths of a 22 year old male and a 49 year old female, who were discovered deceased inside of the residence with fatal injuries to their bodies. The offender then set a couch on fire before fleeing the scene. Guzman was subsequently located and charged accordingly. There is no further information available at this time.
