North Side Man Charged in Police Involved Shooting Incident – 1700 block of North Talman Ave



Name: Rafael Corona, 29

Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One felony count of Armed Habitual Criminal

One felony count of Unlawful Possession of Firearm by Street Gang Member One felony count of Unlawful Use of Weapon – Felon, Possess/Use Firearm

One felony count of Aggravated Assault of a Peace Officer One misdemeanor count of Drinking Alcohol on the Public Way

Bond: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – June 8, 2015

Narrative: Rafael Corona was arrested after pointing a handgun at a Chicago Police

Officer who was responding to a call of a gang disturbance on the 1700 block of North Talman Ave, at approx. 12:05 am on June 7th, 2015. In fear for his safety, the officer discharged his firearm once without striking the offender. Corona was immediately placed into custody and a firearm was recovered. There were no injuries reported and Corona was charged accordingly. He is

scheduled to appear in Central Bond Court on June 8th, 2015.
