Humboldt Park Man Extradited and Charged with Murder



Name: Rasheed Martin, 20
900 block of N. Monticello Ave.

Charges: Murder – First Degree
Two counts of Attempt – Murder – First Degree
Issuance of Warrant

Bond: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – July 29, 2015

Narrative: Rasheed Martin was arrested in Wisconsin and extradited to Chicago after he was identified as the man who shot two people on July 4, 2015 at approximately 11:50 p.m. in the 1100 block of N. Harding. The victims were standing on the sidewalk when Martin fired shots. A 26 year old female was taken to Stroger Hospital in fair condition with a gunshot wound to the chest. A 7 year old male was shot in the chest and taken to Stroger Hospital in critical condition where he was later pronounced. Martin was charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
