ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK - WENTWORTH (2nd) DISTRICT

The Chicago Police Department will conduct a Roadside Safety Check in the Wentworth (2nd) District at the intersection of Garfield Blvd and Perry Ave. The Roadside Safety Check will commence at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, September 25th, 2015 and end at 3:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 26th, 2015.

During roadside safety checks, police officers slow down traffic, stop cars at regular intervals and watch for drivers who show signs of alcohol impairment and other violations as noted below.

"This program is conducted year round to ensure drivers are operating their vehicles safely," said Superintendent, Garry F. McCarthy. "This is part of an ongoing strategy to keep the city streets safe for Chicago's residents and commuters."

The Roadside Safety Check conducted in the Grand Crossing (3^{rd}) District on September 11 - 12, 2015 resulted in the following:
