Robberies 19th **District (Town Hall)**

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 19th District of robberies that occurred recently in the month of October. In these incidents, multiple male offenders approached the victim on the street or in an alley and used force to steal wallets and cellphones. Incident times and locations are listed below:

- 3600 block of N. Sheffield, October 10, 2015 at approx. 3:00 am.
- 3600 block of N. Clark, October 10, 2015 at approx. 11:00 pm.
- 1100 block of W. Addison, October 11, 2015 at approx. 2:40 am.
- 2800 block of N. Ashland, October 15, 2015 at approx. 7:30 pm.

About the Offenders:

- In the incident on Sheffield, both offenders were described as black males, between the ages of 18-21, approx. 5'06-6'01, with slim builds.
- In the incident on Clark, both offenders were described as black males in their 20s, one with dreadlocks and the other with a shaved head.
- In the incident on Addison, both offenders were described as being black males, between the ages of 25-32, approx. 6'00 tall, 165-180 lbs. One offender had dreadlocks and both wore black jackets and blue jeans; one also wore a black baseball cap.
- In the Ashland incident, one offender was described as being a white male, 5'06, with short brown hair and beige pants. The second offender was described as a black male, 6'00 with dreads, wearing a black Nike windbreaker and beige pants. The last two offenders were only described as being two black males, approx. 6'00 tall.

What you can do:

- Always be aware of your surroundings and report suspicious activity immediately.
- If you are confronted by an assailant, remain calm.
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (scars, tattoos, missing teeth, etc) and vehicle descriptions such as make, model, color and license plate number.
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information.
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on scene when possible. If a cell phone is taken, activate any tracking device as soon as possible.
