Responding Officers Perform CPR and Help Save a Man's Life

Chicago Police Officers respond to an "Assist CFD" call in the 3100 block of N. Marmora this morning at 8:20 a.m. First responders on the scene, Field Training Officer Robert Cavaiani and Probationary Police Officer Nicholas Picicci, located a 62 year old man inside his residence, having a medical emergency. The man was unresponsive and not breathing. Officers immediately began CPR and continued until CFD arrived. The Chicago Police Department transported the man to Community First Hospital where he was stabilized. Staff at the hospital accredits the actions of responding Officers as a key factor in helping save this man's life. This is P.P.O. Picicci's first day on the job and one he won't forget.
