Wanted for Commercial Burglaries 004th District (South Shore) 006th District (Gresham)

About This Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens of the 004th (South Shore) and 006th (Gresham) Districts of two commercial burglaries involving financial institutions and their associated properties. In each of these incidents, the offenders approached, used pry tools and other devices to open ATM machines. In one incident, the offenders were successful in accessing money contained therein.

Incident Location and Times:

- 8400 block of South Stony Island Avenue on October 13, 2015 between 3:20 a.m. - 3:40 a.m.
- 8600 block of South Lafayette Avenue on October 26, 2015 at approximately 5:15 a.m.

Safety Tips:

- Report suspicious persons, vehicles, and activities immediately
- Ensure ATM machines are frequently serviced and excessive amounts of money are not contained inside.
- Ensure video equipment/surveillance cameras are on, functional, and recording
- Ensure all doors are properly secured
- Ensure the premise is well light
- If you are confronted by an assailant, remain calm
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide information to the police
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on-scene when possible
