ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK – SOUTH CHICAGO (4th) DISTRICT

The Chicago Police Department will conduct a Roadside Safety Check in the South Chicago (4th) District at the intersection of Brainard and Baltimore. The Roadside Safety Check will commence at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, December 18th, 2015 and end at 3:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 19th, 2015.

During roadside safety checks, police officers slow down traffic, stop cars at regular intervals and watch for drivers who show signs of alcohol impairment and other violations as noted below.

This program is conducted year round to ensure drivers are operating their vehicles safely. This is part of an ongoing strategy to keep the city streets safe for Chicago's residents and commuters.

The Roadside Safety Check conducted in the Gresham (10^{th}) District on December 11 – 12, 2015 resulted in the following:
