Residential Burglaries 018th (Near North) District

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents in the 018th District of Burglary related incidents during the month of **January**. In these incidents, the offender(s) forced entry into an individual residential unit in a multi-unit building and removed property from within. These incidents have occurred in the early morning hours of the day in the general geographical locations listed below:

- Report suspicious activity immediately
- Keep doors and windows secured
- Immediately repair any broken windows, doors or locks
- If video surveillance is available, save and make a copy of the incident for investigating detectives.
- If you are a victim do not touch anything, call police immediately
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
