Three Charged in Uptown Robbery



Offenders: Richard Brooks, 18
5000 block of N. Ashland

2 male juveniles

Charge: Each charged with one felony count of Robbery – Armed W/Firearm

Bond: Brooks - Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – January 18, 2016

Narrative: Richard Brooks and 2 male juveniles were arrested after they were identified as the males who robbed a 23 year old man. This incident occurred in the 1400 block of W. Argyle on January 17, 2016 at approximately 12:40 a.m. The victim was outside when he was approached by four males. These males punched him, produced a handgun, and announced a robbery. They took the victim's cell phone before fleeing. A witness was able to notify police as to the location of the offenders. Responding officers placed three males in custody, recovered the victim's cell phone and recovered a loaded handgun. The male victim sustained non-life threatening injuries and the offenders were charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
