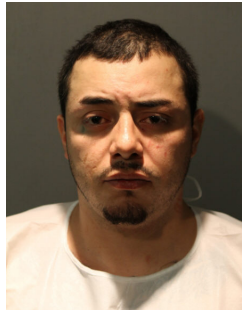

### South Side Man Charged in Domestic-Related Murder



**Offender:** Maurisio Hernandez, 34

**Residence:** 2800 Block of South Short Street  
Chicago, IL

**Charges:** One Felony Count of Murder – First Degree

**Bond:** Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – February 22, 2016

**Narrative:** Hernandez was arrested in connection to a domestic-related incident which occurred in the 2800 block of S. Short Street on February 20, 2016 at approximately 5:45 p.m. Hernandez was identified as the offender who fatally stabbed his 35-year-old girlfriend during an argument. The victim was transported to Stroger Hospital with stab wounds to the neck and she ultimately succumbed to her injuries. Hernandez, a convicted felon and documented gang member, was apprehended a short time later and charged accordingly. No further details are available.
