ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK – Grand Crossing (003th) DISTRICT

The Chicago Police Department will conduct a Roadside Safety Check in the Grand Crossing (003th) District this weekend. The Roadside Safety Check will be conducted at 7424 S. Stony Island, and will commence at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, February 5th, 2016 and end at 3:00 a.m. on Sunday, February 6th, 2016.

The Roadside Safety Check program is conducted year round to ensure drivers are operating their vehicles safely and is part of an ongoing strategy to keep the city streets safe for Chicago's residents and commuters. During these roadside safety checks, police officers slow down traffic, stop cars at regular intervals, and watch for drivers who show signs of alcohol impairment and other violations, as noted below.

The Roadside Safety Check conducted in the Shakespeare (14^{th}) District at 3101 W. North Ave on January 29 – 30, 2016 resulted in the following:
